RESOLUTION NO. 440 (2018)

- WHEREAS, Jennifer Jackson owns Painttown Community Parcels 795 and 796 as shown on the attached GIS map.
- WHEREAS, Ms. Jackson needs a Right of Way from the intersection of Wrights Creek Road and Tramper Road thru Tramper Road to Painttown Community Parcels 795 and 796.
- WHEREAS, the Right of Way crosses Painttown Community Parcels known as No. 129-B and 129-E held by Tammy Wynette Queen, Parcel No. 372-D, held by Sylvester Crowe, Parcel No. 372-C, held by Stuart Dwight Crowe and Parcel No. 730-K held by William Tramper.
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians in Annual Council assembled, at which a quorum is present, that the Tribal Council does hereby grant a 20' Access Road Right-of-Way and Right-of-Way for all utilities to access Painttown Community Parcels known as Parcel No. 795 and Parcel No. 796 and crossing Painttown Community Parcels known as No. 129-B and 129-E held by Tammy Wynette Queen, Parcel No. 372-D, held by Sylvester Crowe, Parcel No. 372-C, held by Stuart Dwight Crowe and Parcel No. 730-K held by William Tramper.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the following stipulations shall be enforced on the aforementioned Access Road Right-of-Way. The easement shall follow the existing road; if it is necessary to widen the existing road within the 20' Road R/W, it will only be expanded on the river side of the road; and all possessory holders who are served or utilize any part of the aforementioned access road are responsible for maintaining the access road.
- BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tribal Business Committee and the Tribal Realty Office, are hereby authorized to carry out the intent of this resolution.
- BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that all resolutions that are inconsistent with this resolution are rescinded, and that this resolution shall become effective when ratified by the Principal Chief.
