- WHEREAS, in 2001, the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians Tribal Council approved the Revised By-Laws of the Museum of the Cherokee Indian. Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians Tribal Council Resolution No. 809 (June 21, 2001).
- WHEREAS, the Revised By-Laws of the Museum of the Cherokee Indian, hereinafter By-Laws, states the Tribal Council shall appoint five members to the Board of Directors and all appointments are subject to Tribal Council's final approval. Revised By-Laws of the Museum of the Cherokee Indian, Art. II, Sec. 2(b) (2001).
- WHEREAS, Museum of Cherokee Indian Board of Directors are appointed for a five year term. *Id*.
- WHEREAS, an individual may only serve as a Board of Director for two consecutive full five year terms after which that individual may not be reappointed until the expiration of one year. *Id.* at (f).
- WHEREAS, there is a Tribal Council appointment vacancy on the Board of Directors due to a member's term expiring on November 30, 2018
- NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians in Council assembled, at which a quorum is present, the Tribal Council appoints and approves, Anita Welch Lossiah, to the Museum of the Cherokee Indian Board of Directors.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Anita Welch Lossiah shall be appointed for the five year term December 1, 2018 through November 30, 2023.
- BE IF FURTHER RESOLVED that Anita Welch Lossiah is not less than eighteen years of age and shall file with the Corporation's secretary a written statement that they are interested in the Corporation's activities, shall attend all meetings and perform the duties of a director unless excused from doing so by the Board of Director's actions. *Id.* at (g).

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED this resolution shall become effective upon ratification by the Principal Chief.
