19	WHEREAS, in Resolution No. 537 (April 9, 2015), Tribal Council confirmed the appointment of
20	Associate Justice Robert C. Hunter to the Cherokee Supreme Court and he has

23	WHEREAS, Resolution No. 537 (2015) stated that Associate Justice Robert C. Hunter's four-
24	year term on the Cherokee Supreme Court began on April 9, 2015, and expired on

28	member of the Cherokee Supreme Court and an asset to the Tribe; and
