WHEREAS, the Charter and Governing Document authorizes and empowers the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians (EBCI) Tribal Council to adopt laws and regulations for the general government of the Tribe. Charter and Governing Document, sect. 23 (Sept. 5, 1995).

RESOLUTION NO. (2019)

- WHEREAS, in an effort to take politics out of the hiring process, the EBCI Tribal Council enacted C.C. §96-12 which allowed the Division Secretary to select an individual for employment. See Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians Tribal Council Ordinance No. 432 (2018).
- WHEREAS, there is a need to amend the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians Personnel Policies and Procedures which allow the Division Secretary to have the discretion to waive the driver license requirement.
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians in Council assembled, at which a quorum is present, the Tribal Council instructs the Attorney General's Office and the Director of Human Resources to amend the EBCI Personnel Policies and Procedures as follows:

Sec. 5.01. Submission of applications. \*\*\*

Driver's license requirements, with the recommendation of the manager, the Executive-Committee Division Secretary will have the discretion to waive the driver license requirement.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that Attorney General's Office and the Director of Human Resources shall carry out the intent of this resolution and this resolution shall become effective upon the Principal Chief's ratification.
