RESOLUTION NO. _____ (2019)

WHEREAS, Sherry Jeanette Taylor (deceased January 21, 2016), enrolled member of the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians did not leave a Last Will and Testament; and

WHEREAS, Christopher Southards qualified as the Administrator of the estate of Sherry Jeanette Taylor in Cherokee Court Estate File 16-014; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Realty Office has examined the records on file regarding the deceased's possessory holding in Tribal trust land, and other documents, and has written this resolution to provide for the distribution of the deceased's possessory holding to her eligible heirs; and

WHEREAS, the Administrator requests Tribal Council recognize the deceased's eligible heirs under Tribal law, and to provide for the distribution of the deceased's possessory holding to her eligible heirs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians in Council Assembled, at which a quorum is present that the Tribal Council of the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians does hereby recognize the heirs of Sherry Jeanette Taylor: Larch Edward Taylor (enrolled), Jose Luis Guerrero (enrolled), Cleo Cherice Golden (enrolled).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that **Cherokee Community Parcel No. 26 (Part of Parcel No. 23)**, containing 1.06 acres, more or less, together with all improvements located thereon, be assigned to Larch Edward Taylor (enrolled), Jose Luis Guerrero (enrolled) and Cleo Cherice Golden (enrolled).

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tribal Business Committee and the Tribal Realty Services are hereby authorized to carry out the intent of this resolution.
