- WHEREAS, The Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians Office of the Attorney General and Legal Assistance Office provide necessary representation in Family Safety Court cases involving children, elders and vulnerable adults who are involved with legal proceedings with the EBCI Family Safety Program; and
- WHEREAS, Additional staff is needed to improve the quality of legal services available to Cherokee individuals in these proceedings and help the cases proceed more quickly, which is in the best interest of children and adults; and
- WHEREAS, these changes in service provision require the addition of a Family Safety Attorney under the Office of the Attorney General, the additions of four Attorneys and one Paralegal in the Legal Assistance Office, and changes in the title and job descriptions of the Manager and two Attorneys currently in the Legal Assistance Office; and
- WHEREAS, these additions and changes have been approved by Executive

 Committee and leadership is currently identifying vacant positions that
 may be used to maintain the practice of managing net adds of FTEs;
