RESOLUTION NO. _____ (2019)

- WHEREAS, the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians Tribal Council is the governing body for the Tribe and realizes that providing nutrition and other supportive services is vital to the health and well-being of the reservation elderly which is a high priority to the Council; and,
- WHEREAS, the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians Tribal Council has in the past supported Title VI of the Older American Act of 1966, as amended; and,
- WHEREAS, the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians, being a sovereign governing entity and wishing to continue the practice of self-determination in the operation of their own aging program; and,
- WHEREAS, the Senior Citizens Program of the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians has secured a funding source from the Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) Administration for Community Living (ACL); and,
- WHEREAS, this funding source does not pay for salaries; and,
- WHEREAS, there is no grant match required; and,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians at which quorum is present that the Senior Citizens Program of the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians Youth and Education Division be authorized to apply and accept funds from DHHS, ACL for the budget period of 04/01/2020 – 03/31/2023.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Principal Chief is authorized to carry out the intent of the resolution, which shall remain in effect until implemented or rescinded.
