16	WHEREAS,	BIA Building No. 1 is owned and controlled by the United States represented

19	WHEREAS,	the BIA is prepared to declare Building No. 1 as surplus property and to transfer it
20		to the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians; and

22	WHEREAS,	Building No. 1 has fallen into disrepair and upon transfer, the Tribe intends to
23		make repair and upgrades to use as office and storage space for the Tribal Realty
24		Services Division to accommodate its current work, as well as added duties and
25		responsibilities under the future P.L. 93-638 contract to assume the Cherokee
26		Agency's realty program, and provide office space for the Office of the Attorney
27		General; and
28 29	WHEREAS,	on January 23, 2020, the Tribe, through Principal Chief Richard G. Sneed, sent a
30	WIIEREAS,	Letter of Intent to the BIA requesting that Building No. 1 be transferred, which is
31		attached to this resolution; and

33	WHEREAS,	in addition to the Letter of Intent by Principal Chief Sneed, the BIA has asked
34	***	Tribal Council to express in an official resolution that the Tribe requests the BIA
35		to declare Building No. 1 as surplus property and to transfer all right, title and
36		interest to the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians.

38	NOW, THER	REFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians, in Council
39		Assembled at which a quorum is present, that the Tribal Council of the Eastern
40		Band of Cherokee Indians hereby officially requests that the Bureau of Indian
41		Affairs transfer to the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians all right, title and interest
42		in BIA Building No. 1, located at 257 Tsali Boulevard, Cherokee, North Carolina.
43 44	RE IT EIIDT	THER RESOLVED, the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians also requests the
45	DETTTOKI	associated funding for operations and maintenance of Building No. 1,
46		Maintenance Worker (WG-4749-07 1010007), and enough of the surrounding

1 7	grounds, as illustrated in the Tribe's Letter of Intent and accompanying map and
18	photographs, to allow for vehicle parking and normal access to and maintenance
19	of BIA Building No. 1, including use of the loading dock and all entry and exit
50	doors.

52	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the vehicle parking area immediately surrounding BIA
53	Building No. 1 will continue to be a shared-use parking area, such use being
54	shared by the Tribe and the Cherokee Agency.

56	BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the Principal Chief and Tribal Realty Services are
57	authorized to take such actions as are necessary to carry out the intent of this
58	resolution.
