20		to comply with it, and due to increased contracting costs will put entities				
21		and programs in financial jeopardy; and

23	WHEREAS,	the sole purpose of the TERO Fee is to provide a funding source for TERO				
24		with the hope of making TERO self-supporting, but Tribal Council is				
25		currently funding TERO through the Tribe's regular budgeting process and				
26		will continue to do so; and

29		Fee will not jeopardize TERO's on-going operations but will give Tribal Council the time it needs to re-visit the law and make modifications; and
