- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians in Council Assembled, at which a quorum is present that the Tribal Council of the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians does hereby recognize the heirs of Allen Boyd Queen: Felicia Gail Commander (enrolled), Lara Aimee Alvarez (enrolled), and Norman Dale Queen (enrolled).
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Wolfetown Community Parcel No. 197-C (Part of Parcel No. 197), containing 7.511 acres, more or less, be assigned to Felicia Gail Commander (enrolled), Lara Aimee Alvarez (enrolled), and Norman Dale Queen (enrolled).
- BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tribal Business Committee and the Tribal Realty Services are hereby authorized to carry out the intent of this resolution.
