Resolution No. 108 (2020)

- WHEREAS** the Cherokee Police Commission is established in Cherokee Code § 120 to oversee Tribal law enforcement programs, including personnel actions and internal investigations, and;
- WHEREAS** Cherokee Code Sec 120-4 states that the Commission shall consist of eight members representing the six Tribal townships, and each member is nominated by the Principal Chief and approved by Tribal Council, and;
- WHEREAS** Resolution 90 (2016) appointed seven Commissioners, whose term expired September 2019, and;
- WHEREAS** there remains a Painttown position on the Commission that is currently vacant, and;
- WHEREAS** there is a need to provide consistency within this Commission, which warrants staggered term limits for the Commissioners, and;
- WHEREAS** per this resolution, Principal Chief Richard Sneed is nominating the tribal members named below to update this Commission with a plan for staggered term limits.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians in Council assembled at which a quorum is present that Principal Chief Richard Sneed hereby nominates, and Tribal Council approves, Reuben Teesatuskie (Yellowhill) and Frank Herron (Cherokee Co./Snowbird), to be re-appointed to the Commission to serve an 18 month term to ensure consistency within the Board, with their term expiring May, 2021.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the individuals named below are hereby nominated by

Principal Chief Sneed, and approved by Tribal Council, to serve an 18 month term in the At Large Commission positions, with their term expiring May, 2021.




