Resolution No. 218 2020

WHEREAS:

it has been a tradition among the Cherokee people to give special recognition to

Cherokee women and on occasion men who have made special and unique

contributions to the Cherokee people; and

WHEREAS:

it is customary to recognize and esteem those women and men who have distinguished

themselves amongst their peers by continually creating a positive impact on their

community, our traditional culture, and posterity on our tribe.

WHEREAS:

such outstanding persons have been recognized as a "Beloved Woman" or "Beloved

Man" of the Cherokee people; and

WHEREAS:

the Tribal Council established the Beloved Women Committee to lead the efforts in

defining the contemporary qualifications, commitments, and stipulations of the

"Beloved" honor and to develop and oversee the nomination process and events for the

Beloved title.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians in Council assembled, at

which a quorum is present, that the Tribal Council hereby approve the Beloved

definition, qualifications, commitments, stipulations, and nomination process developed

by the Beloved Women Committee.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the established Beloved Women Committee shall proceed with the 2020

Beloved Nomination process and provide selected nominees for Tribal Council

consideration at the start of fiscal year 2021.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that this resolution shall become effective upon ratification by the Principal

Chief of the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians.
